



The Road Runner Regional Rodeo RV Park is now accepting reservations for the following dates:

Thursday February 11, 2010

Friday February 12, 2010

Saturday February 13, 2010

Sunday February 14, 2010

Reservation arrivals are placed in the park on a first come first serve basis. The earlier you arrive, the better your chances of getting the spot you may want. Folks may begin arriving for check in as early as Thursday at 2 PM. All rigs, campers and tents must vacate the Rawhide property no later than 12 noon on Monday.

Pricing is as follows:

- For Thursday night arrivals there is a \$25.00 charge.
- Friday and Saturday night camping and entry into the rodeo for Saturday and Sunday is \$100.00, this is a package for two. Any extra people camping with you are \$15.00 each. (This package price DOES NOT include the Friday night dinner being held at the grounds. Any food or drinks made available by Rawhide or the Rodeo Association are for purchase and are not included as part of the package or individual camping night fees.)
- For those staying over Sunday night, there is an additional \$25.00 charge.
- Tent camping is available for \$5.00 per person, per night.

All reservations can be made on line via the secure payment link. This will act as your deposit. Any additional charges for extra night's, or extra people in your party, must be settled at the time of your arrival.



There are restrooms available for public use on the grounds, there are however no showers. There is NO DUMPING of grey or black water from any motor home or camping rig anywhere on the grounds. There are no water spigots available. Bring what you need.

Electricity will be provided on a first come first served basis. There are 50 slots available with electric that is providing 110 volt circuits at 20 amp service. If you plug in and overload the outlets you will be asked to unplug. You must bring your own extension cables, and adapters you might need to plug in. Electricity is not provided for tent campers. As we have to provide our own power, the generators will run from 9PM to 7AM. The times are limited to help offset the fuel cost.

Campers who bring their own generators are allowed to use them as they need to during the day, but are required to shut them off for the quiet hours between 10 PM and 7AM so as not to disturb other campers.

If you are planning on having a campfire, please check with camp host upon arrival to make sure that a "NO BURN DAY" is not in effect for the county we are operating in. Allowed campfires must be in a contained metal pit. **ABSOLUTELY NO GROUND FIRES ALLOWED!! NO BON FIRES!! No FIRES ON ANY GRASS AREAS, Keep it low, keep it legal, keep it in control. If you can't control it, you will be asked to put it out.**

There are no fireworks allowed anywhere on or around the RV Park or Rodeo Grounds. There are NO Firearms allowed on or around the RV Park or Rodeo Grounds. Anyone caught with any of the aforementioned items falling into either category will be asked to leave.



Consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed at your campsite, by those of LEGAL drinking age (21 in the state of Arizona). Alcoholic beverages must remain at your campsite, and cannot be taken into the town of Rawhide, into the pavilion area, or anywhere classified as “The Rodeo Grounds.”

Non aggressive dogs are allowed in the RV park area, but must remain on a leash or crated at your site, and should not be left unattended at any time. Dogs are not allowed in the arena or barn or pavilion areas.
